Study Skills to the 4th Power

Dear 3rd grade parents,

It is hard to believe that the school year is close to an end. I know the students have worked very hard this year. As I begin to prepare for the closing of the school year, I would like to fill you in on a program I will be offering this summer. We are calling it Study Skills to the 4th power. During the month of June, (Tuesdays and Thursdays), I will be offering students an opportunity to continue working on study skills as they prepare for 4th grade. I am going to continue a Math Club to review material covered this year, and also introduce material that will be covered in 4th grade. We will also work on the Summer Math workbook together. The workbook is a requirement for 4th grade.) The workbook will be turned in at the beginning of the school year and will count as a test grade.

In addition to Math Club, I am also going to offer a Book Club. We will read and discuss story elements of one, maybe two books. I will choose the books from the incoming 4th grade reading list. Various activities will be incorporated to go along with each book. We will work on character analysis, identifying story elements, and incorporate story maps. Some chapters may be assigned for homework. This will help us to analyze and get through our books within a timely fashion.

I feel this is a great way to keep the kids busy and thinking during the summer. If you think your son/daughter might be interested, please fill out the attached form and return as soon as possible. Space will be limited. I am only going to accept a total of 10 kids. However, we will need at least 6 students to make the class. **The fee for Study Skills to the 4th Power will be \$200 for eight sessions beginning June 6, 2017 and ending June 29, 2017. All checks should be made payable to me, Margaret Adame.** We will meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 9:00-11:30. Students will be allowed to bring a mid morning snack. I look forward to continuing the learning process with your kids as they transition to 4th grade.
