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## HEAD INJURY REPORT

Dear Parent/Guardian,

If you were informed that your child suffered a head injury while at school today, please observe for the following symptoms and contact your doctor or emergency room immediately if you notice any of these signs.

- A constant headache that gets worse, “pressure” in head
- Slurred speech
- Dizziness that does not go away or happens repeatedly
- Bothered by light, noise
- Memory problem
- Extreme irritability or abnormal behavior
- Nausea or vomiting
- Confusion or clumsiness
- Oozing blood or other watery fluid from the nose or ears
- Difficulty waking up or excessive drowsiness
- Unequal size of the pupils (the dark center part) of the eyes
- Unusual paleness that lasts for more than an hour
- Convulsions (seizures)
- Blurred vision or double vision
- Feeling sluggish, hazy, foggy or groggy

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
