## NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION PROCEDURES (2021-2022)

**How to apply?** Visit [www.Shcsaints.org](http://www.Shcsaints.org) to apply. Select Admissions/How to apply and download the new student application/forms. New student registration packets are returned to the school office from February 8-12, for priority registration. (NEW students or NEW siblings only). The following documents must be returned with your application to complete your application to St. Helen Catholic School:

- Copy of student birth certificate/baptismal/1<sup>st</sup> communion
- All previous report cards and/or standardized testing
- Teacher recommendation
- Day care recommendations for PK (if applicable)
- Application fee of \$100 per student

### Admissions Testing

All new students must complete an entrance exam. Testing time varies but may last up to 90 minutes. The entrance exam assists in determining where the student currently functions academically. Due to COVID parents are not allowed to wait in the building.

### Testing Schedule and What to Expect?

- The PK4-8th grade testing/screening process begins at 9 a.m. on March 27, 2021.  
Note: Please arrive fifteen minutes early to check-in. For PK & K testers, a parent checklist will be available for completion. Please turn it in when you pick up your student.
- PK4 must be 4yo before Sept 1<sup>st</sup>, and Kindergarten must be 5yo before Sept 1<sup>st</sup>.
- PK3 testing will be scheduled when application is submitted. (May 3-13, 2021)
- PK3 applicants must be 3yo before Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>, and in some cases, a 2<sup>nd</sup> screening may be needed prior to acceptance.

### Potty Training (PK3, PK4 and Kindergarten)

All students must be completely potty trained prior to the first day of school. St. Helen does not have the staff to assist your child with potty training. Complete potty training is required prior to acceptance.

Potty training is defined as follows:

- Verbally identifying the need to use the bathroom
- Pulling down articles of clothing to get to the toilet
- Wiping him/herself with no assistance
- Independently replacing articles of clothing removed for toileting

**Special Needs:** SHCS offers an academically rigorous curriculum. We do have an Intervention Specialist on staff, but we must be aware of any special needs your child has. Please identify them on the student application, as this will not prevent your child from registering.
