



## Traveling Chalice



The purpose of the Traveling Chalice Program is to encourage families to pray for vocations as a family and to promote vocations within the family. Each week a student from St. Helen Catholic School, along with his or her family, will receive the Traveling Chalice at Friday morning Mass. They will have the chalice for a week and should place it in a prominent place in their home to serve as a reminder of the importance of their prayers. We ask that families pray for vocations within our Church, but most especially, for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life which is so needed today. Participating families will also have the opportunity to journal about their experiences. Please note that journaling and attending mass to receive the chalice will count as service hours. Praying for an increase in vocations will NOT count as service hours.
